The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is between	21st Nov - 22th Nov 2023

In respect of the 2023-2024 school year, the total number of applications for admission received by the school was 197

Number of Offers made and accepted under each criteria:	Category 1 - Brothers of present and past students and who apply by the due date - 51 places	
	Category 2 - Pupils from the listed Primary schools who apply by the due date and who reside in the Roman Catholic parishes of Clondalkin and Sruleen - 69 places	
	Category 3 - 52 applicants were from the listed Primary Schools but did not reside in the defined Catholic parishes of Clondalkin and Sruleen and who applied by the due date were eligible for the remaining 24 places under Category 3.	
	Of the 52 applications, the remaining places were determined by random selection and allocated the remaining 24 places with the school's policy regarding twins applied where necessary.	
	28 pupils who were not offered places under Category 3 were then ordered by random selection and allocated 1-28 on the waiting list.)	
	Category Four The remaining 16 applicants who did not fulfil the criteria in categories 1, 2 or 3 were then randomly selected and allocated numbers 29-44 on the waiting list. Another applicant with a twin was selected as number 35 so his brother was automatically selected as number 36 on the waiting list. These names were selected randomly by the members of the panel present.	
	Category 5 - 9 late applications have been received after the closing date. All late applications were dated and timed. (Please note that late applications on behalf of siblings were given priority over other late applications for a period of ten school days after the official closing date.) Late applications were placed in date order on the waiting list after all other applicants who applied by the due date.
