The school will commence accepting applications for admission on	Monday 5th Oct 2026
The school shall cease accepting applications for admission on	Fri 23rd Oct 2026 at 2pm
The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is between	09th Nov - 13th Nov 2026
The period within which applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission is between	25th Nov - 26th Nov 2026

In respect of the 2025-2026 school year, the total number of applications for admission received by the school was 201

Breakdown of places allocated for the 2026/2027 school year:

Number of applications received:	175
Number of Offers made and accepted under each criteria:	Category 1 - Brothers of present and past students and who apply by the due date - 43 places Category 2 - Pupils from the listed Primary schools who apply by the due date and who reside in the Roman Catholic parishes of Clondalkin and Srulleen - 67 places Category 3 - 42 applicants were from the listed Primary Schools but did not reside in the defined Catholic parishes of Clondalkin and Srulleen and who applied by the due date were eligible for the remaining 34 places under Category 3. Of the 42 applications, 34 applicants were determined by random selection and allocated the remaining 34 places with the school's policy regarding twins applied where necessary. The remaining 8 pupils who were not offered places under Category 3 were then ordered by random selection and allocated 1- 8 on the waiting list.) Category Four The remaining 23 applicants who did not fulfil the criteria in categories 1, 2 or 3 were then randomly selected and allocated numbers 9 - 31 on the waiting list. These names were selected randomly by the members of the panel present. Category 5 - 1 late application was received after the closing date. All late applications were dated and timed. (Please note that late applications on behalf of siblings were given priority over other late applications for a period of ten school days after the official closing date.) Late applications were placed in date order on the waiting list after all other applicants who applied by the due date.
